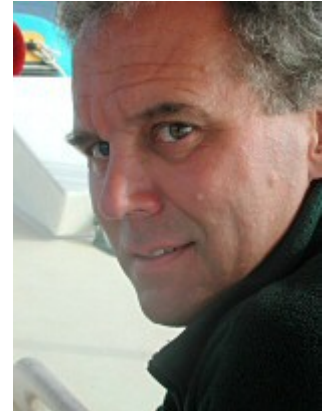

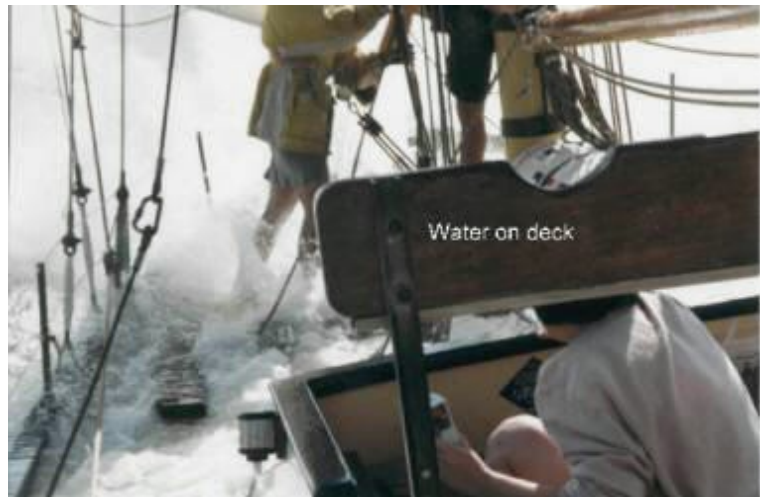


2000 MCA Class IV Yachtmaster Modules completed. Short trips as captain mainly sail training.
